### **Enviro monitoring - Ian**

- Woodman point as a site, north of sediment dredging
- Monitor sea grass by running transects closer to the edge towards to the site  
Use between groins as control site  
Monitor - Shoot density, seedling recruitment
- Southern flats
- 3 hectare sea grass meadow site  
10m x 10m plots, randomly chose 24  
Drop camera – monitor fish species  
Compare transplant and natural meadow  
Issues – observer error
- Fall bank – more thought needed
- Spoke to MVK about a 2 hour workshop the day before using coral finder/ coral point count
