1. Previous Items / Progress from Last Meeting

1A. MUEnSA Collaboration - WA Clean-Up Week October 2025

- KL The tentative location is South beach. However, it is not really a dive spot.
- LS suggested Omeo wreck as it allows MUD to be more engaged.
- **JP** Ammo jetty is better than Omeo, Omeo has a lot of seaweed, making it harder to see trash and it is not as accessible. Ammo jetty also has a lot of trash. However, Ammo jetty can be extremely busy with a lot of fishermen, making it dangerous for divers.
- FI If we want to go in the water, we should choose a site where we are comfortable going with people.

1B. Collaboration with a Swan Dive instead of Perth Scuba

1C. Sustainability grant

- FI May get more funding since not many clubs applied for the sustainability grant.

- **JP** Should be doing it in week 12, week 13 and 14 students will be too caught up in examinations, week 14 is halloween week.
- FI From the last cleanup where we collected a crab net, Olivia crocheted a coral effect before and was thinking of making an art project with the crab net using collected trash from the cleanup dive. Will be 100% funded by her. Does not have to be in September, can be in November or December etc. Need to discuss when to do it. Considering doing it after examinations.
